## Dundalk Community Center to open with ceremony

The grand opening of the Dundalk Community Center on Trading Place is set for Monday, July 27, at 11 a.m.

Young at Heart Senior Club moved its facilities into the building on June 29 and is operating out of the new space, as is the Family Crisis Center, which will have a separate entrance on Commerce Street.

The renovated building will also house a Police Athletic League center, a computer lab, activity rooms and Baltimore County Recreation and Park facilities, according to Angela Heffner, a spokeswoman for Baltimore County.

A six-lane indoor swimming pool will be managed and operated by the YMCA. The county came up with a loose agreement with the organization so non-YMCA members can have access to the newly

renovated aquatic center year round, Heffner said.

The YMCA "will open the pool for community use," she said.

Community swim times vary throughout the year. Swimming costs are \$3 per day for children 11 years old and under, \$7 for those

12 and older and \$4 for seniors. The pool will be open after the ribbon-cutting ceremony later this month.
