

TEEN LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

Counselor in Training (CIT)

(entering grades 9-10)

Our remodeled Counselor In Training (CIT) program is designed to help teens develop leadership, character and the skills needed to work with youth. Participants must apply for the CIT program and are selected through an interview process. If selected, teens must commit to three Saturday trainings before the start of camp. A schedule of required and elective trainings is available at ymaryland.org. Once successfully completed, teens must participate in a minimum of four weeks in the CIT program. Evaluation and reviews will be conducted for CITs who meet or exceed the four-week minimum and the hours in the program will be recognized for service hours that may be required for high school graduation.

STEP 1 - GET PREPARED

STEP 2 - REGISTER FOR CAMP

- Select your weeks and click the blue register button. Complete all requested information.
- Checkout by making your payment. If you have a promo code, you will use it at checkout.

During your initial registration, you must accept a waiver stating that you agree to be charged a one-time, non-refundable, non-transferable registration fee (per camper). The fee will be added to your Y account and charged to the credit card used at the time of registration. If the fee is \$0 during a promotion, you must still accept the waiver. Please Note: If you register for additional camp weeks at a later date, the waiver will reappear and must be accepted, however you will not be charged an additional registration fee.

STEP 3 - NEW COMPLETE MEDICAL FORMS & CAMP PACKET

Once you've registered for your camp weeks you will be emailed a link to our new camp paperwork system, CampSpace. Use this link to create your CampSpace account and complete all required health and medical forms and our 2020 camp packet. Registration Fee

Sibling Discounts

Deposits

Camp deposits are required to hold your child's space in each week of camp. Deposits are per week/per camper and are non-refundable, non-transferable, and applied to the total camp fee. If camp is paid in full during the initial registration, a portion equal to the deposit is considered non-refundable and non-tranferable. Not subject to discounts.

Camp Changes

Camp changes can be managed online at no cost through June 1st.
Any changes made after June 1st are

subject to a \$5 processing fee. Any changes made after a promotional period are subject to the full rate.

Balance of Weekly Camp Fees

Payments for all day camps will be automatically drafted from the payment method used at the time of registration 14 days prior to the start of the camp week.

Payments for overnight camp will be automatically drafted 30 days prior to the start of the camp week.

A complete payment schedule is included in the Camp Parent Manual. If the balance is not paid, the camper will not be permitted to attend camp and the slot may be reassigned.

Open Doors Financial Assistance

Financial assistance is available through the Y's Open Doors assistance program. Applications will be accepted starting Jan. 1, 2020. Please apply early as funds may be limited. Applications are available online at ymaryland.org/opendoors. Due to a change made by the MD State Department of Childcare, we are no longer able to accept CCS vouchers for camp. We encourage families who use this service to

apply for Y financial assistance. Discounts and promotions cannot be combined with financial assistance. CCS vouchers are still accepted at Y preschool summer programs.

Cancellation Policy

All changes and cancellations must be made in writing and include: camper's full name, camp location, dates of the weeks to be cancelled, description of the request.

Deposits and registration fees are non-refundable/non-transferable.

All requests must be submitted to the Customer Service Office by fax at 410-779-9426 or email to customerservice@ymaryland.org.

If a day camp week is cancelled two weeks prior, the deposit will be forfeited and any further balance paid will be refunded. Cancellations made with less than two weeks notice will not be accepted and all fees will be non-refundable.

For overnight camp, cancellation requests must be made 30 days in advance.


