	Green Band	 Permitted in the shallow and deep ends of the pool without a PFD; also permitted to use the slides Parent/guardian MUST be on the pool deck
10 to 12 years	Red Band	 MUST have an actively engaged parent/guardian in the water within arm's reach and in water below armpit level; OR Child MUST wear a US Coast Guard approved personal floatation device, remain in the shallow end, and be directly supervised by a parent/guardian on the pool deck
	Yellow Band	MUST stay in the designated shallow water area and parent/guardian MUST be on-site
	Green Band	 Permitted in the shallow and deep ends of the pool without a PFD; also permitted to use the slides Parent/guardian does NOT need to be on the pool deck; however, the parent/guardian MUST be on-site
13 to 17 years	Red Band	 MUST have an actively engaged parent/guardian in the water within arm's reach and in water below armpit level; OR Teen MUST wear a US Coast Guard approved personal floatation device and remain in the shallow end
	Yellow Band	MUST stay in the designated shallow water area
	Green Band	 Permitted in the shallow and deep ends of the pool without a PFD; also permitted to use the slides Parent/guardian does NOT need to be on-site
18 years & over	Unspecified	Lifeguards may ask participants 18 and over to take a swim test if it is determined that the member may not be safe in the deep end independently
